## Milestone

Exelon purchased Handley from TXU Corporation in April 2002. In May 2003, the SCR Project (Selective Catalytic Reduction), to reduce NO<sub>x</sub> emissions, was completed on both Units 4 and 5, and in 2004 on Unit 3, reducing NO<sub>x</sub> emissions 90 percent.

## History

Site generation dates back to 1902, when the Northern Texas Traction Company built a generating plant, the largest in the area, along the adjacent Lake Erie, now known as Lake Arlington, a popular recreation and amusement area. When the first still-active Unit 1 was built, it was the first outdoor steam electric generating station of its type in the industry.
