## Milestone

Cromby Unit 1 is Exelon's most utilized generator, with more than 322,000 operational hours.

## History

The first generator on the Cromby site was a 1904, 350-kW water turbine, Razor's Meadow Electric Plant, replaced in 1918 with a "modern" 10,000-kW building, and then retired in 1929. The present station houses Cromby Unit 1, which is a leader in its use of emissions control systems. Cromby Station Unit 1 celebrated its 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of efficient power production in 2004.
