## **Exelon Nuclear's Fishing for a Cure** Benefiting *Autism Speaks*

The goal of Autism Speaks is to change the future for all who struggle with autism spectrum disorders. Autism is a complex neurobiological disorder that impairs a person's ability to communicate and relate to others and typically lasts throughout a person's lifetime. Today, 1 in 150 individuals is diagnosed with autism. Autism Speaks raises money to fund new research to uncover the cause, help with prevention and treatments, and find a cure for autism.

The entry fee is \$100 per team (two anglers per team) – all proceeds, including 100% of all entry fees, will go to Autism Speaks. All participants will receive a "Fishing for a Cure" T-Shirt, courtesy of Exelon. All anglers must compete from a boat with a minimum length of 16 feet with kill switches and aerated live wells. Anglers must be at least 16 years old or accompanied by an adult to compete. No live bait and no illicit drugs or alcoholic beverages permitted during competition. All boats must maintain a minimum of \$100,000 liability insurance. Life vests must be worn any time the big motor is running. All participants must sign a liability release waiver before commencement of tournament. Winners may be administered a polygraph prior to the issuance of prize monies. Anglers must comply with all state boating and fishing regulations. There is a three fish per team limit and minimum length of 15 inches. There will be penalties for short or dead fish. Exelon will have final authority for weigh in and will determine prizewinners.

Registration is limited to the first 100 teams, though tournament officials may allow ramp sign-ups on the day of the event and can allow the number to exceed 100. Make Checks payable to **Exelon Nuclear** and mail to:
