

Generation

Exelon Generation is one of the world's largest power producers and wholesale marketers, with a competitive retail entity. Exelon Generation has one of the nation's largest portfolios of electricity generation capacity with access to approximately 33,500 megawatts of owned and contracted electricity, and a nationwide reach with strong positions in the Midwest, Mid-Atlantic, and Texas. Exelon Generation comprises Exelon Nuclear, Exelon Power, Exelon Power Team, and Exelon Energy.

Exelon Nuclear is responsible for operating the largest nuclear fleet in the United States and the third largest in the world. Exelon's ten stations and 17 nuclear units, located in Illinois, Pennsylvania, and New Jersey, represent approximately 20 percent of the U.S. nuclear industry's power capacity.

Exelon Power manages, operates, and maintains the company's fossil (coal, oil, and natural gas), landfill gas, and hydro generation assets in Illinois, Maryland, Massachusetts, Pennsylvania, and Texas. The current fleet is composed of 108 units capable of generating more than 8,000 megawatts.

Exelon Power Team is the wholesale power marketing division responsible for developing and implementing Exelon Generation's long-term sales and supply strategy, as well as the physical delivery of power and optimization of Exelon Generation's portfolio of assets. Power Team's 24/7 operation includes generation dispatch, weather and load forecasting, transmission congestion management, and fuel logistic operations.

Exelon Energy Company is Exelon's retail marketing organization specializing in the supply of natural gas and electricity to commercial and industrial customers and has been serving customers since 1998. Exelon Energy currently markets electricity to customers in Illinois and Michigan and natural gas to customers in Illinois, Michigan, and Ohio.
