- Exelon Nuclear: 100 percent

- When construction began: Oct. 1, 1974
- When units entered commercial service: Unit 1—Oct. 20, 1982
Unit 2—Oct. 19, 1984
- Operating license: Unit 1 is licensed to operate until 2022,
Unit 2 until 2023.

- Annual payroll: Approximately \$56 million
