- **Location:** Located approximately six miles east of Clinton, Ill., and approximately 20 miles north of Decatur, Ill.

- **When construction began:** 1976
- **When unit became 100% operational:** Sept. 15, 1987
- **Operating license:** Unit 1 is licensed to operated until 2026.
