

# Rider 30 – The Alliance

*(interruptible/load response service)*



Choose the option that fits your needs.  
Earn rewards year round.

Pick the Firm Power Level that best suits your business' operations.

Rider 30 – The Alliance, is a partnership that offers you flexible options for electricity interruption or usage-reduction along with substantial financial benefits. Through pre-arranged agreements for the interruption or reduction of electricity use throughout the year, you can receive credits applied against your monthly electricity bills.

This flexible partnership provides three options that allow you to tailor the program to your needs, letting you choose the level of financial benefits, advance notification, and maximum frequency and length of reduced energy use. Regardless of the option you choose, ComEd can help you determine your Firm Power Level (FPL as defined in the tariff).

- Load Response Option A: With 10 minutes notice, ComEd will automatically turn off your company's electric power to a pre-determined Firm Power Level, limited to eight hours per load response event.

- Load Response Option B: With two hours notice, ComEd notifies you to reduce electrical load to a pre-determined Firm Power Level, limited to six hours per load response event.

- Load Response Option C: With four hours notice, ComEd notifies you to reduce electrical load to a pre-determined Firm Power Level, limited to six hours per load response event.

To participate in the program, your company must have discretionary electrical loads that are easily interruptible or reducible upon notice. To make the logistics easier, ComEd will install an alert system and printer to simplify notification. You must provide dedicated phone lines. In addition, a nominal monthly administration fee will be assessed. A two-year commitment is required. 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# Program Highlights

<b>Requirements</b>	<p>Participants must be non-residential customers taking service under Rate 6L, Rate 6T or Rate 6T Time of Day Elective.</p> <p>Participants must be willing to reduce their electric load to a Firm Power Level (FPL)*.</p> <p>Participants must have discretionary electrical loads that are easily interruptible or reducible.</p> <p>A minimum two-year, self-renewing contract is required.</p> <p>A nominal \$110 monthly administration fee is charged to your account.</p> <p>Additional charges may apply if notification equipment is needed. (Participants must supply dedicated phone lines and internal wiring.)</p>					
<b>Payment Amount</b>	<p>Payment for all options will appear as a credit on your monthly electricity bill throughout the year. Rates differ by season and according to demand. (See Program Incentives chart below.)</p>					
<b>Notice</b>	<p>Participants will be notified through an alert system installed by ComEd.
