

*Exelon Nuclear*

Exelon Nuclear is headquartered in Warrenville, Ill., and is a business unit of Exelon Corporation. It operates the largest nuclear fleet in the nation and the third largest fleet in the world. Exelon's 10 stations – with 17 reactors – represent approximately 20 percent of the U.S. nuclear industry's power capacity. Chip Pardee is President and Chief Nuclear Officer, Exelon Nuclear.

Exelon Nuclear's 17 generating units produced 131.3 million net megawatt-hours of electricity in 2009. The fleet also achieved an average capacity factor of 93.6 percent, the seventh year in a row the capacity factor was more than 93 percent.

There are about 8,400 nuclear professionals working in Exelon Nuclear. Whether serving at a site or at Exelon Nuclear headquarters, these professionals implement industry best practices to ensure safe, reliable operation throughout the fleet.
