Exelon Nuclear Hosts Community Information Night To Discuss Groundwater Remediation Progress

BRACEVILLE, Ill. (Jan. 8, 2007) — Exelon will host a Community Information Night on Jan. 17 to provide updates on the on-going project to clean up tritium from groundwater near Braidwood Generating Station.

The information night will be from 4 to 7 p.m. at Exelon's Training Center, 36400 S. Essex Road, Wilmington. Exelon representatives will be on hand to discuss the progress of remediation, enhancements made to the station's discharge pipe ("blowdown line") and releases of plant-generated tritium.
