**Exelon Nuclear Hosts Community Information Night On March 22
To Discuss Groundwater Remediation Progress
*Information on Braidwood Station's property tax assessment available***

BRACEVILLE, Ill. (March 12, 2007) - Exelon Nuclear will host a Community Information Night from 4-7 p.m. on Thursday, March 22 to provide updates on Braidwood Generating Station's on-going tritium remediation project and the plant's property tax assessment.

The information night is open to the public. It will be at Exelon's Training Center, 36400 S. Essex Road, Wilmington.

Exelon representatives, technical experts and officials from state agencies will be on hand to provide information and answer questions on a one-on-one basis with attendees about the ongoing remediation of tritium in groundwater. In addition, information will be provided about Braidwood Station operations, property taxes and community involvement.

Hydrogeologists working for Exelon recently evaluated the impact of the remediation efforts that began in June 2006. They will be on hand to explain the results of recent testing, which confirms that the remediation is working as planned.

In addition to information about the remediation efforts and the property tax assessment, instructors at the training center will lead tours of a control room simulator between 4 - 6:30 p.m. Tours will provide the public with a sense of what happens inside Braidwood Station's control room. The Braidwood Police Department will have Atom, a crime-fighting dog donated by the station, on hand to give crime-fighting demonstrations. Atom's demonstrations will begin at 4:30 p.m.

Exelon Nuclear will be sponsoring a children's coloring contest. Winners from different age groups will win a \$100 savings bond. Adults will have a chance to enter a drawing to win tickets to a Chicago White Sox game. Take-away information will be available and food and refreshments will be served.
