

Be Electrically Safe With Gabby Green!

Electricity is super important and makes everyone's life a lot easier! But it can also be dangerous – especially if you're not careful or paying attention to what you're doing around it! Here are some Gabby Green tips to ensure you are safe around electricity!

- Always let an adult plug things in that you want to use.
- But if you have to do it yourself, don't touch the metal tips sticking out of the plug while putting it in the wall and always push the plug in using the head of the plug! (If you don't know what the head of a plug is, be sure to ask an adult to show you!)
- Never stick anything into an outlet other than an electrical plug.
- Tell an adult if a cord from a lamp or another item that needs electricity is in your way or if it might be tripped over!
- Turn off anything that needs electricity by using the power switch – never pull the plug out of the wall to turn something off.
- If you have to unplug something from the wall, pull the cord out by the plug and not by the cord.
- Remember to never carry something by the cord – always carry electrical items in the right way – ask an adult if you're not sure how items should be carried or moved.
- Never pry open something that is plugged into the wall – if it's not working correctly, tell an adult.
- Ask an adult to put plug covers into wall outlets that aren't being used. These covers can help keep fingers out of the outlets!
- If you ever see a wall outlet sparking or making a funny noise, tell an adult immediately!
