Exelon Nuclear to Host Community Information Night November 8

BRACEVILLE, Ill. (Oct. 17, 2007) – Braidwood Generating Station will host a Community Information Night on Thursday, Nov. 8. The event will run from 4 to 7 p.m. and will give members of the public an opportunity to get information regarding the plant's operations.

Information on the station's ongoing tritium remediation project will be available. Maps, fact sheets and other information about tritium at Braidwood Station are available online at www.BraidwoodTritium.info, or at Fossil Ridge Library, 386 W. Kennedy Road, Braidwood. Also featured at the event will be Atom, Braidwood Police Department's crime-fighting dog who was donated by the station. The police will facilitate crime-fighting demonstrations that involve Atom.

The station's information night is open to the public and will be held at Exelon's Services and Training Center located at 36400 S. Essex Road in Wilmington. Take-away information will be available and food and refreshments will be served.

Braidwood Generating Station is approximately 60 miles southwest of Chicago. The station's two nuclear energy units can produce a total of more than 2,300 megawatts at full power - enough electricity to power more than two million homes.
