Braidwood Station to Install New Monitoring Wells

BRACEVILLE, Ill. (September 26, 2007) – Contractors for Exelon Nuclear’s Braidwood Generating Station will begin drilling new monitoring wells on Monday, Oct. 1. The wells are being drilled as part of Exelon’s ongoing tritium sampling and monitoring program. The drilling will be completed the week of Oct. 1.

From time to time, Exelon expects to bring in equipment to drill new monitoring wells to ensure continued accuracy in its ongoing tritium remediation work. The new wells will be installed south of Braidwood Station’s blowdown line near Smiley Road.
