## **Braidwood Station Information Night Set For July 17; New Location and Time**

**BRACEVILLE, Ill.** (July 7, 2008) - Exelon will host its next Community Information Night on Thursday, July 17. The information night will be held from 5 to 8 p.m. at Cinder Ridge Golf Course, 24801 Lakepoint Drive, Wilmington.

“We’ve changed the venue and time of our information nights based on feedback we’ve received,” said Bryan Hanson, Braidwood Station Site Vice President.

Exelon representatives, technical experts and officials from various agencies – including the NRC, IEPA and IEMA – will be on hand to provide information and answer questions on a one-on-one basis with attendees about the operation of Braidwood Station.

Guests can visit various tables with information pertaining to the plant’s operations, including a table explaining the Radiological Environmental Monitoring Program (REMP) in place at Braidwood Station. Exelon will also have an updated plume map and will answer questions regarding tritium remediation.
