## **If You See Drilling Equipment, Braidwood is Putting in New Wells**

**BRACEVILLE, Ill.** (March 23, 2007) – Contractors for Exelon Nuclear’s Braidwood Generating Station began drilling two wells on company owned property Tuesday, Mar. 21, as part of its ongoing tritium sampling and monitoring program. The drilling will be completed over the weekend.

From time to time, Exelon expects to bring in equipment to drill new sampling wells on company property to ensure continued accuracy in its ongoing tritium remediation work.
