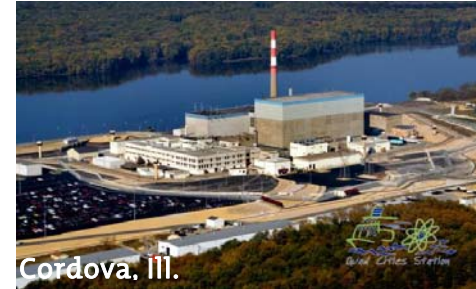


QUAD CITIES GENERATING STATION

Generation

- Number of units: 2 operating units
- Total site net generation: 1,793 net mw
- 2009 net generation: 14,564,270 net mw-hr
- Customers served: 1.2 million homes
- 2009 capacity factor: 94.4 percent

- Boiling Water Reactor: General Electric

Site Features

- Site size: Approximately 765 acres with Mississippi River intake
- Location: Located in Rock Island County, on Route 84

Ownership

- Exelon Nuclear: 75 percent
- MidAmerican Energy: 25 percent

Construction

- Plant builder: General Electric
- Consulting engineer: Sargent & Lundy
- When units entered commercial service: Unit 1—February 1973
Unit 2—March, 1973
- Operating license: Both units licensed to operate until 2032

Community Impact

- Number of employees: Approximately 800
- Annual payroll: Approximately \$56 million
- 2009 taxes paid: Approximately \$4.7 million (supports county and township government, area schools, libraries and other taxing bodies).
