

Generation

Exelon Generation is the No. 1 competitive power generator in the nation, with owned generating assets totaling approximately 34,650 megawatts. With strong positions in the Midwest, Mid-Atlantic, Texas and California, Exelon is the largest owner and operator of nuclear plants in the United States and maintains a growing renewable energy development business headquartered in Baltimore.

Exelon Generation comprises Exelon Nuclear and Exelon Power:

- **Exelon Nuclear** is responsible for operating the largest nuclear fleet in the United States and the third largest in the world. Exelon's 10 stations and 17 nuclear units, located in Illinois, Pennsylvania and New Jersey, represent approximately 20 percent of the U.S. nuclear industry's power capacity.
- **Exelon Power** is responsible for managing, operating and maintaining the company's fossil (coal, oil, and natural gas), renewable (landfill gas, waste wood, wind and solar) and hydroelectric fleet of generating assets. With generating assets located in 15 states and in Canada, Exelon Power can provide more than 15,000 megawatts of safe, efficient and environmentally responsible baseload, intermediate and peak power generation.
