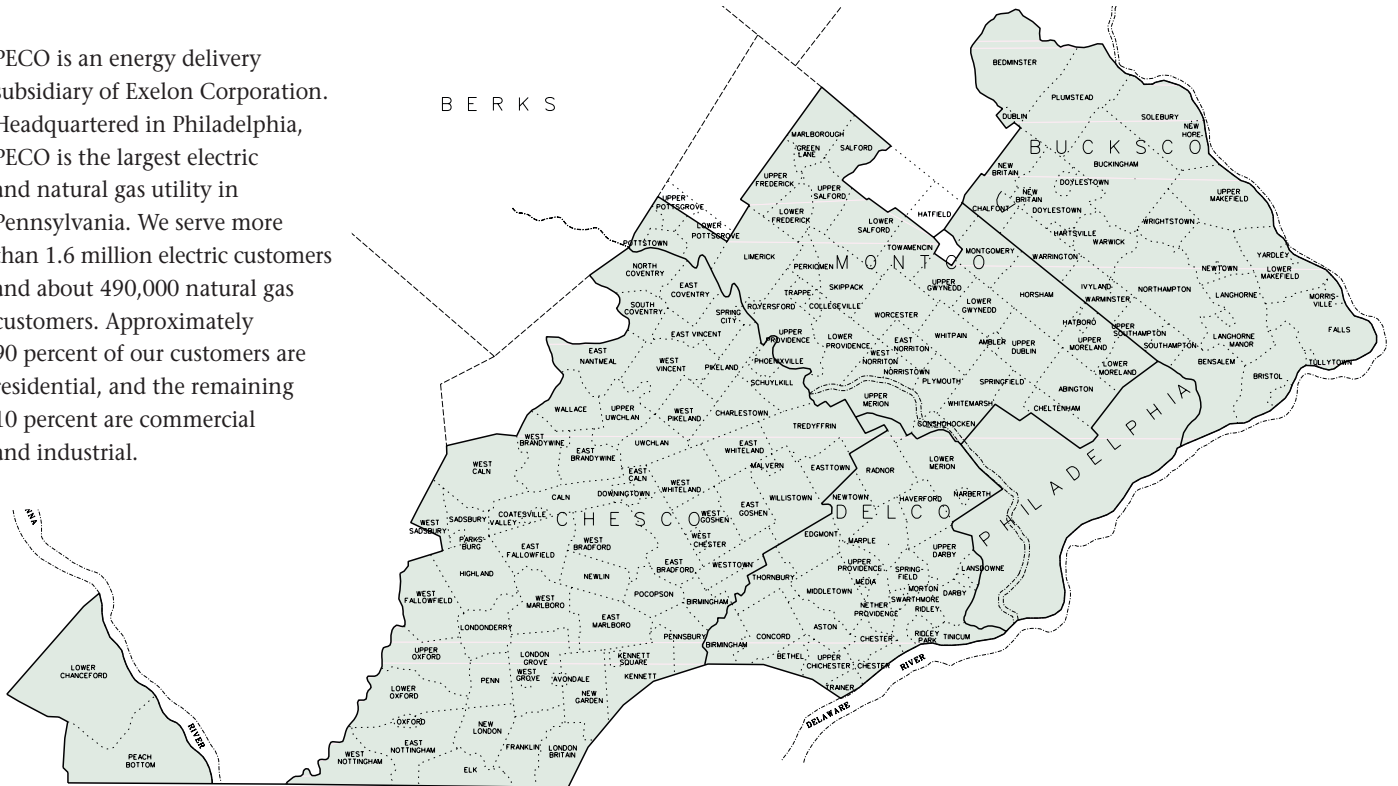

PECO is an energy delivery subsidiary of Exelon Corporation. Headquartered in Philadelphia, PECO is the largest electric and natural gas utility in Pennsylvania. We serve more than 1.6 million electric customers and about 490,000 natural gas customers. Approximately 90 percent of our customers are residential, and the remaining 10 percent are commercial and industrial.



PECO BY THE NUMBERS

To keep the lights on and the natural gas flowing for our customers, we operate:

- 500 power substations
- 29,000 miles of distribution and transmission lines
- 29 gas gate stations
- 6,600 miles of underground gas mains

We are committed to providing reliable service to our customers. We have invested more than \$1.2 billion in infrastructure improvements and operations during the last five years.

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FOR OUR CUSTOMERS:

- With PECO Smart Ideas, our full suite of energy efficiency programs, we have energy-saving products and programs to help save money in every home and business. Here are some ways to reduce energy costs right now:
 - More than 700 stores currently sell PECO discounted CFL bulbs. These light bulbs use up to 75 percent less energy and last about 10 times longer than traditional light bulbs.
 - PECO is paying rebates to customers who purchase qualified energy-efficient appliances.
 - PECO is paying incentives to customers who allow us to pick up older, energy-wasting refrigerators and freezers.
 - PECO pays residential customers \$120 a year (\$30/month June–September) to remotely manage central air-conditioning systems during times of high demand for electricity.
 - PECO offers an online home energy audit to help customers understand how they currently use energy and how they can use less.

FOR OUR COMMUNITY:

- PECO is one of the Greater Philadelphia Region's most active corporate citizens, providing about \$5 million each year to support numerous arts and culture, education, environmental, economic development and community programs and organizations
- \$5.1 million in United Way contributions from employees, retirees and the company
- \$900,000 in PECO Green Region grants to projects to help communities preserve open space through environmentally



FOR OUR ENVIRONMENT:

- Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Existing Building (EB) silver and gold certification from the U.S. Green Building Council for six local buildings and additional upgrades to secure LEED certification for 5 additional company buildings
- A 45,000 square foot green roof—to reduce storm water runoff by more than 60 percent and reduce peak roof temperatures by more than 60 degrees for improved energy efficiency at our Main Office Building.
- A new energy efficient Crown Lights message system using the latest in LED lighting technology—uses 20 percent less energy than the previous system and provides several thousand dollars of additional savings in bulb replacement costs.
- An 11 percent increase in hybrid vehicles and the conversion of all diesel trucks to biodiesel—in total, environmentally friendly vehicles now make up about 60 percent of PECO's fleet.
