Dear Valued Supplier:

Nearly two and a half years after the start of the COVID-19 pandemic, we at Exelon have re-entered the workplace while remaining focused on the safety of employees and contractors. As a result of vaccines, boosters and an effective re-entry, Exelon has modified some of our COVID-19 protocols.

This communication applies to both supplier-managed and staff augmentation contractors, and it is consistent with a prior communication sent to Exelon employees and staff augmentation contractors on July 6, 2022.

Effective immediately:

- Employees and contractors no longer need to wear a mask or social distance, **regardless** of vaccination status, **unless** required by a local jurisdiction, instructed to do so by Exelon OHS under our return-to-work protocols after testing positive for COVID-19, requested by an Exelon customer when on or in a customer's premises, or Exelon institutes additional safety requirements.
- If you **test** positive, contact your employer and Exelon OHS at 1-800-558-0039 for next steps. If you have developed a more specific protocol with Exelon or its Operating Companies for reporting positive cases, continue to follow that protocol.
- We are discontinuing the use of stickers by employees and contractors (reference March 17, 2022, communication for historical details).

Please remember that any contractor can choose to continue to wear a mask while performing Exelon work. Exelon-provided masks will continue to be available at most Exelon work locations.

As always, safety is our highest priority. Exelon will continue to monitor local COVID-19 conditions, such as hospitalization rates, as we have throughout the pandemic. Additional safety measures, including masking and social distancing, may be implemented by Exelon in the future.
