



Semi-Annual Report of Corporate Political Giving and Other Contributions

Reporting Period: July – December 2025

Exelon actively participates in the political process to promote sound energy, economic, and environmental policies that address the needs of our customers, communities, and other stakeholders and create value for our investors. Exelon is committed to providing transparent disclosure about those activities.

This report includes a listing of the following corporate contributions made during the Reporting Period (July 2025 to December 2025):

- political contributions, including to entities organized under 26 U.S.C. §527, made by Exelon and its subsidiaries for the noted reporting period in compliance with Exelon's Corporate Political Contributions Policy (available on Exelon's website),
- contributions to entities organized under 26 U.S.C. §501(c)(4),
- contributions or membership dues from Exelon to trade associations organized under 26 U.S.C. §501(c)(6), including the portion used for expenditures that, if made directly by Exelon, would not be deductible under 26 U.S.C. §162(e)(1)(B),
- non-profit organizations that received matching gifts over \$5,000 from the Exelon Foundation as a result of contributions from senior executives.

Exelon may not always agree with the political positions taken by trade associations or chambers of commerce to which we contribute; however, we believe our contributions to these organizations provide an overall benefit to the company. This report is reviewed by the Corporate Governance Committee of the Exelon Board of Directors semi-annually.

Contributions attributed to Exelon Corporation may also include contributions from Exelon Business Services Company, LLC.

Contributions attributed to Pepco Holdings, LLC (PHI) may include contributions by Atlantic City Electric Company (ACE), Delmarva Power & Light Company (DPL), and Potomac Electric Power Company (Pepco).

Note: Exelon and its subsidiaries have several bipartisan PACs that are funded solely through voluntary employee contributions and offer eligible employees a direct means to voluntarily participate in shaping public policy and expressing views on issues related to our business. Exelon provides limited administrative support to each PAC. The disclosures in this report do **not** include contributions made by any of Exelon's PACs. Consistent with U.S. federal and state laws, Exelon's PACs file reports at the federal, state, and local levels. Exelon PAC makes contributions to federal candidates and committees while Exelon's subsidiary PACs make contributions at the state and local level. These reports are available from the Delaware Department of Elections, District of Columbia Office of Campaign Finance, Illinois State Board of Elections, Maryland State Board of Elections, New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission, Pennsylvania Department of State, and the U.S. Federal Elections Commission.
