

Michigan Wind Projects

Exelon Generation has wind projects in 10 states, including five projects in Michigan. In total, these five projects, Beebe, Harvest I, Harvest II, Michigan Wind 1 and Michigan Wind 2, are capable of producing 352.6 megawatts (MW) of clean energy.
